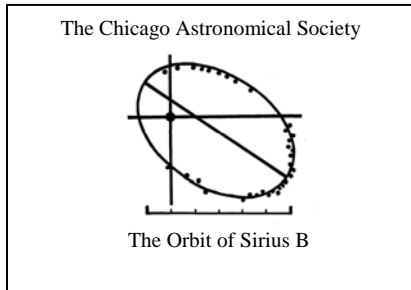
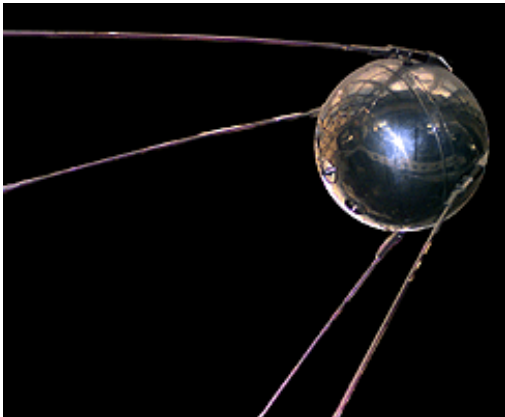

Welcome to the public, teachers, students, scouts, hobbyists...everyone!

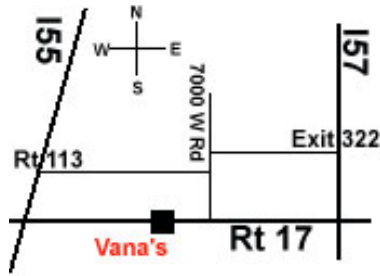
